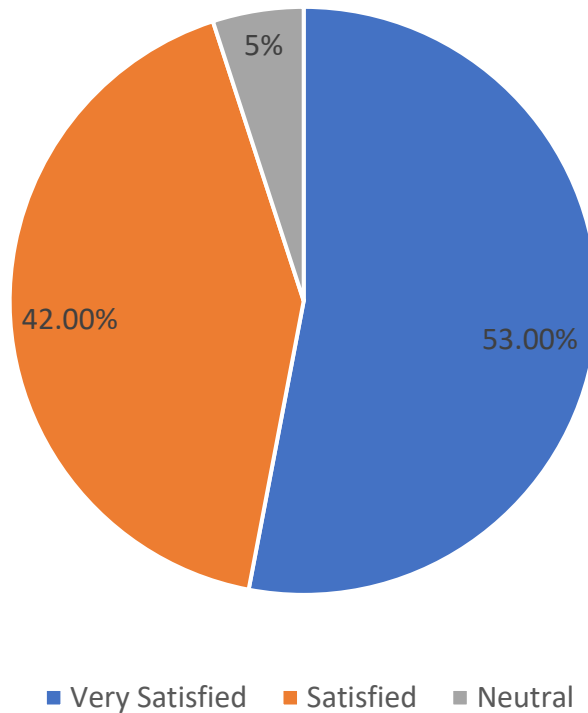

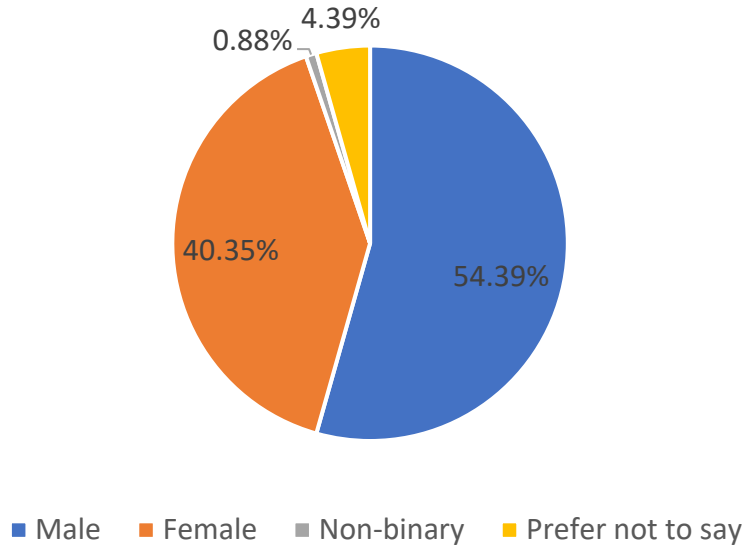
Overall Satisfaction



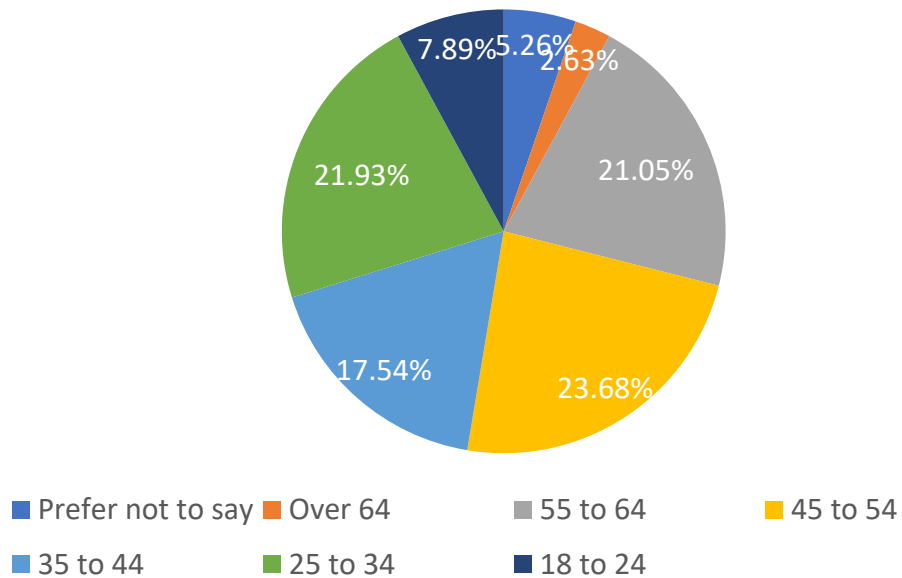

The survey is based on Likert Scale with the 5-point response level

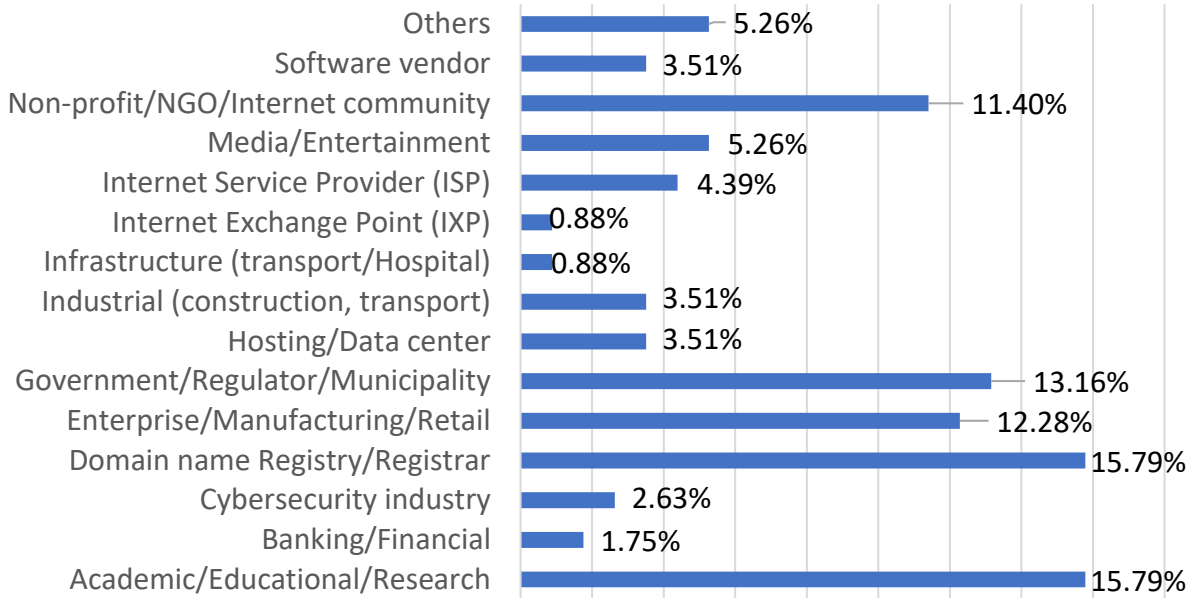
Gender

Taiwan Network Information Center (TWNIC), as a part of the global Internet ecosystem, hopes to establish a policy forum focusing mainly on domain names and IP related issues from the global network architecture. Code of Conduct of the ICANN APAC-TWNIC Engagement Forum

Expected Behavior

It is expected that participants behave properly and positively at all times: showing respect and courtesy to others whenever possible, and ensuring a safe and inclusive environment.

We hope that all attendees feel welcome and comfortable to participate fully, therefore we are committed to providing an environment free of the following unacceptable behaviors:

- Discrimination, whether based on a person's race, ethnicity, culture, national origin, social or economic class, educational level, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, age, size, family status, political belief, religion, or mental or physical ability.
- Misbehavior including disturbance to others or to event proceedings, misuse of property, trespass, theft or other antisocial acts.

Consequences

- Unacceptable behavior by any participants, including those with decision-making authority, will not be tolerated. Anyone asked to stop unacceptable behavior is expected to comply immediately.
- If a participant engages in unacceptable behavior, we may take any action deemed appropriate, including temporary ban or permanent expulsion from the event without warning.
- If you are subject to or witness unacceptable behavior, or have any other concerns, please notify our staff as soon as possible.
