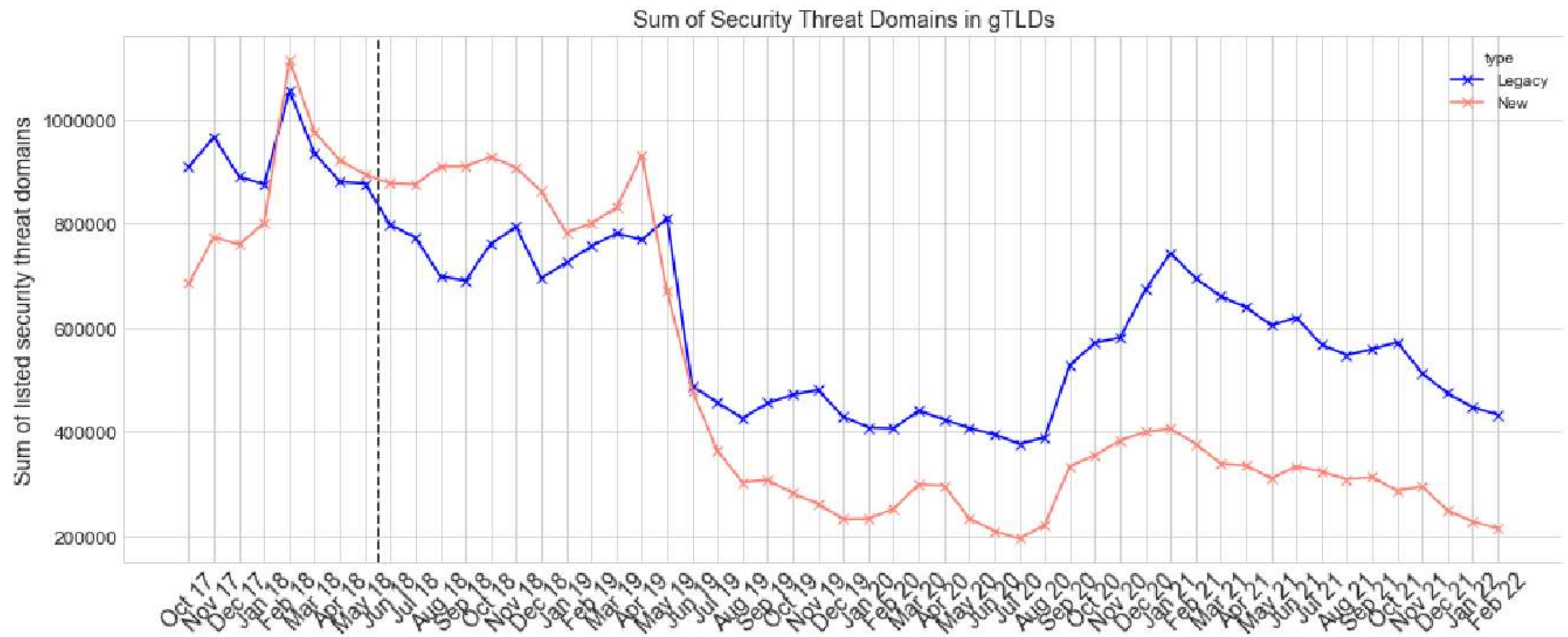


Figure 2 - Sum of absolute counts of security threat domains across threat gTLD types over time



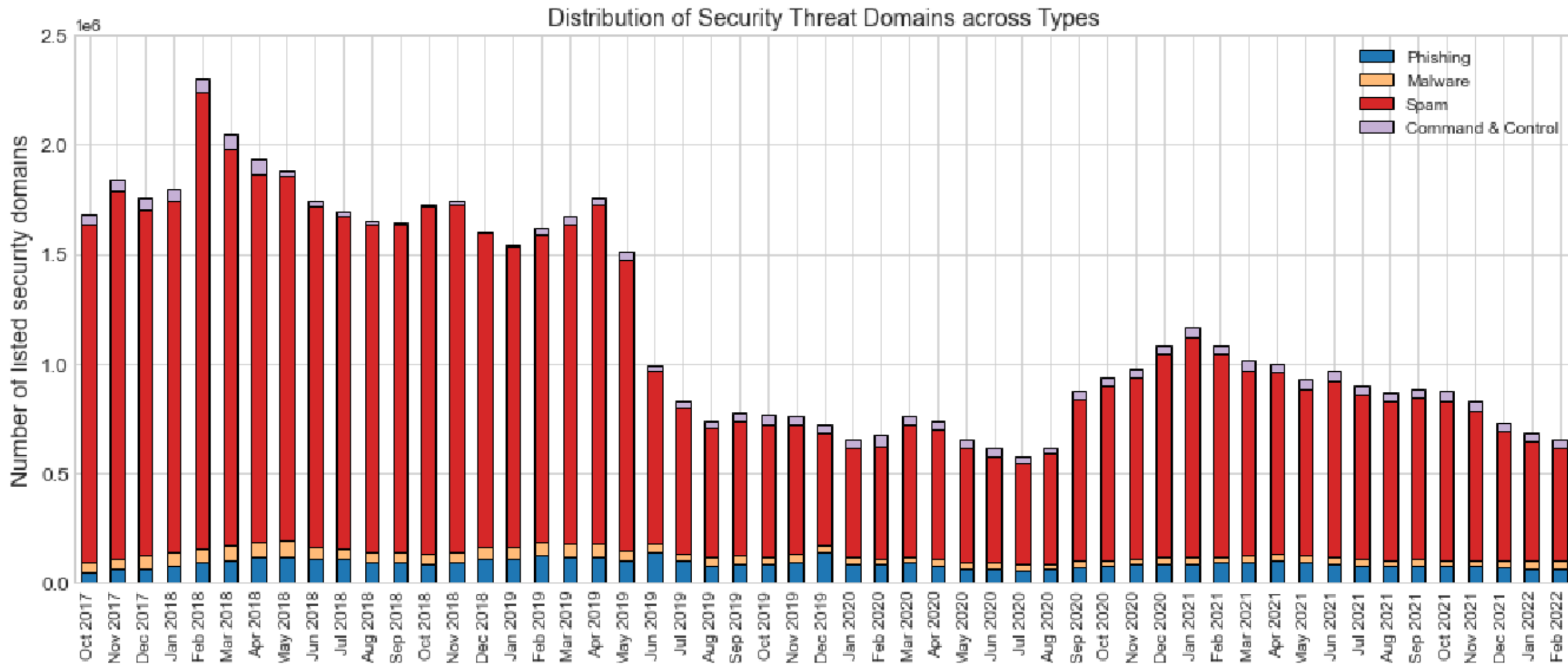


Figure 4 - Distribution of security threat domains across threat types over time

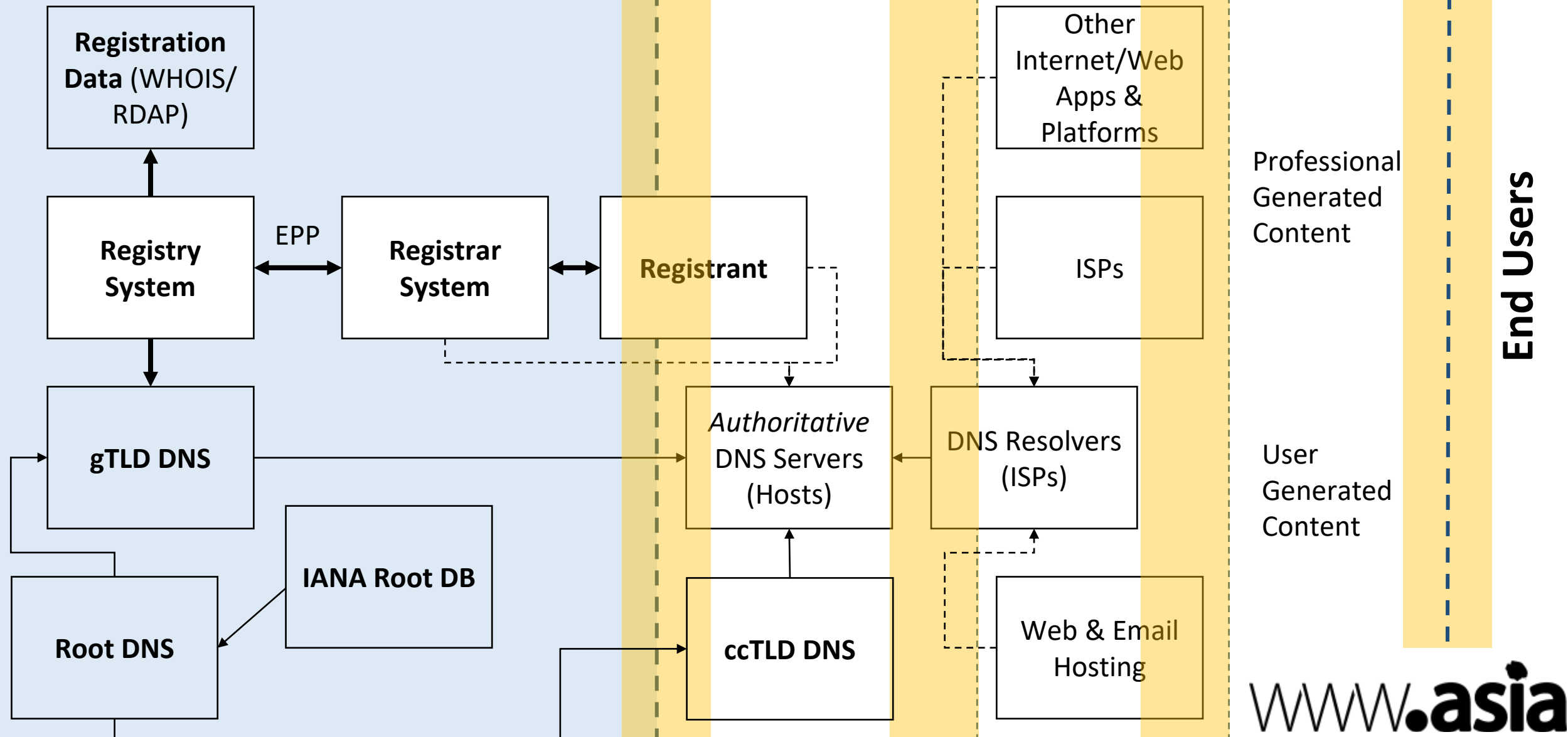

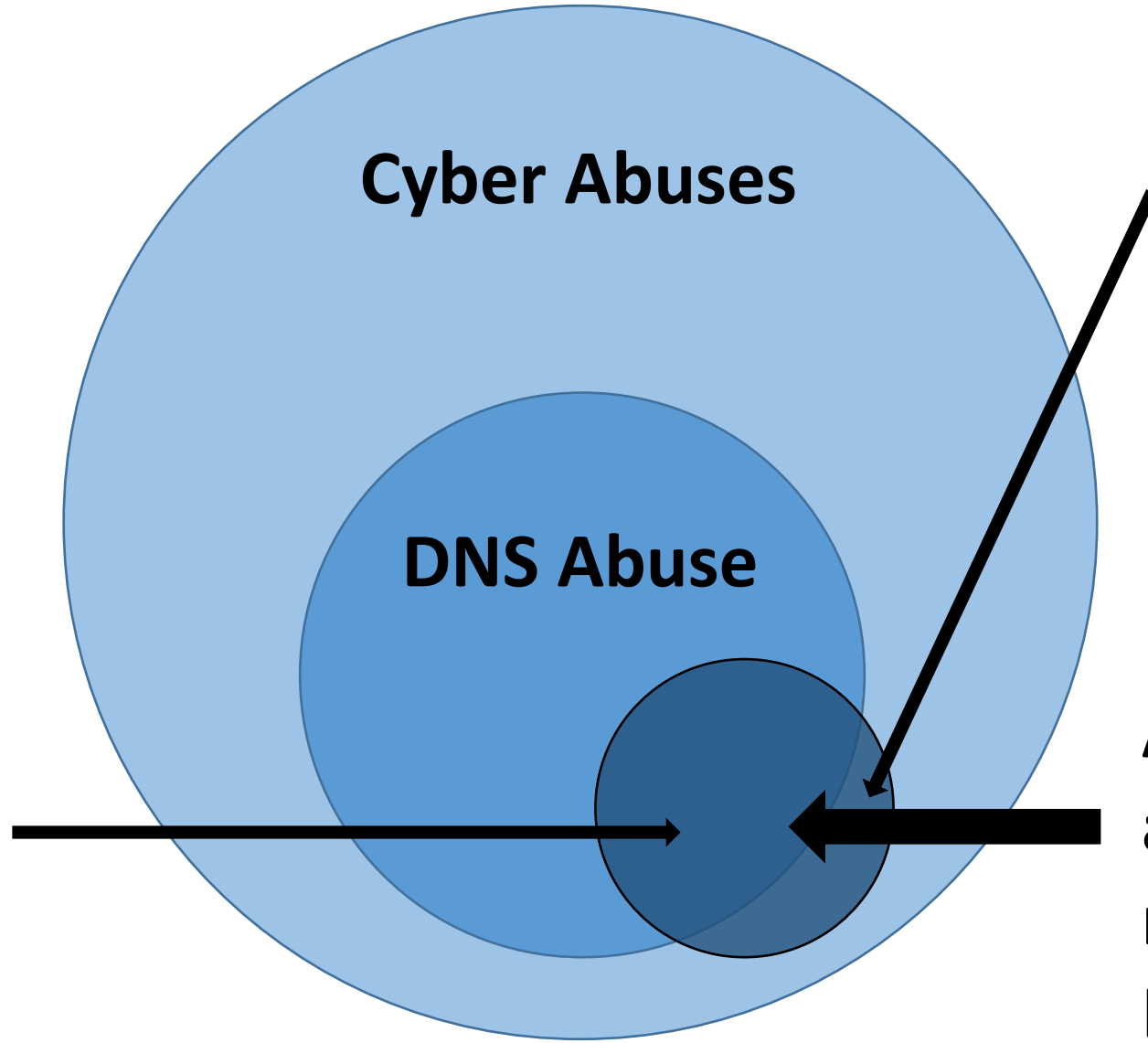

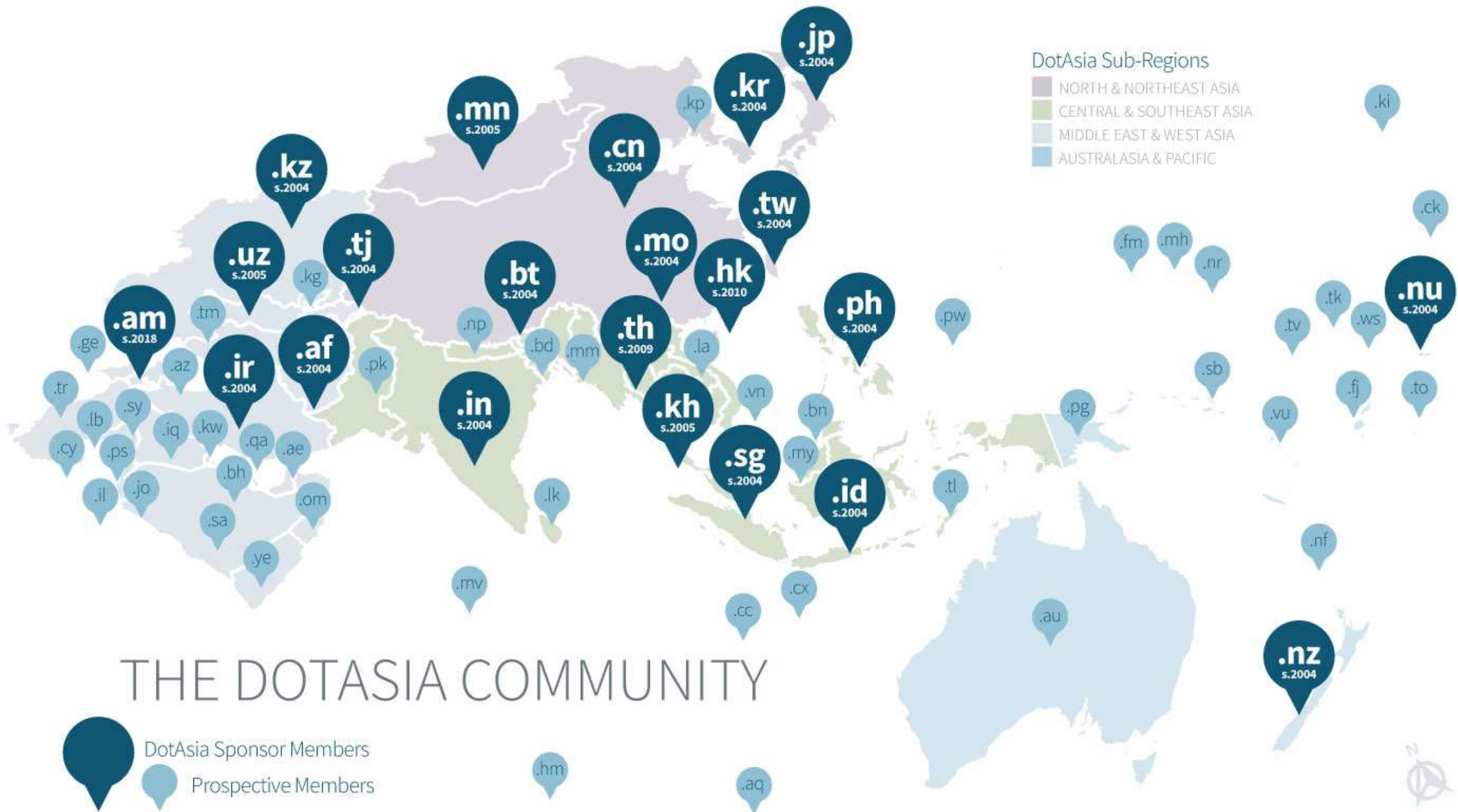
