- 1 in 4 alumni continue active participation in Internet governance

ICANN NextGen & Fellowship

Applications are open
for ICANN75 NextGen in Sep 2022!



The **NextGen@ICANN** program focuses on education, awareness, and future engagement.

Applicants must be between the ages of 18 and 30, and live and be enrolled in some type of higher learning curriculum in the region where the ICANN Public Meeting is being held.

About 20 to 30 candidates are selected per meeting to engage in customized, topical discussions.



The **Fellowship** program focuses on capacity building and fast immersion into the ICANN community.

Applicants must be at least 21 years of age, meet other selection criteria, and be interested in continuing engagement as volunteers in the multistakeholder model.

About 60 Fellows are chosen to attend two ICANN Public Meetings. Another 40 Alumni are chosen for the smaller Policy Forum Meeting.
